Authorizing the Director of Water Services to execute an \$11,816,607.32 construction contract with MegaKC Corporation, for the Vertical Wells 2-5 Replacement project; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$13,000,000.00; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

David Poirier and Blake Anderson, Water Department, presented. This project involves replacing 4 of the City's 14 water wells that serve treatment plants along the Truman Road area. During the winter months, water levels in the wells tend to run low; these updates are intended to improve reliability and help mitigate fluctuations in water supply. There is a phased plan to address the remaining wells (Wells 6-14). A separate plan has been developed for Well #1 due to its current condition and overall health. Construction is scheduled to take place over the summer months. The contractor, MegaKC, was present at the meeting. Funding for the project is secured through a General Obligation (GO) Bond, which will cover the associated costs. These improvements are critical to maintaining adequate water capacity for both residents and visitors, particularly during periods of increased demand in the warmer summer months. Authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to execute a Piggyback contract that will exceed the \$1,000,000.00 contract threshold with Genuine Parts Company dba NAPA to provide parts and operate three storerooms in City facilities through April 30, 2027; authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to amend the contract and exercise the City's seven one-year renewal options; and authorizing the Director of General Services and the Director of Aviation to execute lease(s) and extend the leases for use of City storerooms in City facilities.

Phillip Asante, General Services Department, presented. This ordinance authorizes contracts for the procurement of parts through Sourcewell, with NAPA Auto Parts serving as the supplier. These parts will support both the General Services and Aviation Departments. The contract provides discounted pricing and includes warranty coverage on all parts. The City has maintained a working relationship with NAPA for over 25 years, supplying parts for ground equipment, City vehicles, Fire Department vehicles, and other municipal fleet needs. The ordinance also includes renewal of the contract, with provisions for negotiated pricing to ensure overall cost efficiency. A representative from NAPA was present at the meeting. Councilmembers requested additional discussion regarding the procurement process. Specifically, they asked for a detailed report outlining current procurement procedures, including timelines, to be presented as future business in order to improve understanding of the process.
