## City as Lead Public Agency

- City issues RFP on the behalf of the 55,000 agencies that utilize the USC program
- City's procurement and contracting processes are followed
- Supplier must meet local and national requirements
- fee to offset the cost of contract management USC & City (as the Lead Public Agency) share an administrative
- USC receives 2% of aggregate purchases against contract; the Lead Public Agency receives 5% of this amount

### Our Solicitation Process

- Electrical, Telecommunication and Security products and related services
- Estimated national value of \$250M (City = \$400,00) annually
- RFP issued 09/06/2017, utilizing RFP365 (electronic platform)
- Notices posted on City website and DemandStar
- 199 invitations sent, 68 accessed RFP (RFP365)
- 27 suppliers notified and 4 downloaded (DemandStar)
- 3 proposals received and evaluated by the selection
- Multiple-agency team comprised of representatives from **General Services Departments)** County (VA) and the City of Kansas City (Public Works and North Carolina State University, Maricopa County (AZ), Fairfax
