## Resolution 2024:03 Prepare Annual Report and Related Actions Adopted January 25, 2024

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 150780, adopted on September 17, 2015, and pursuant to the Community Improvement District Act, Sections 57.1401 et seq., RSMo, as amended ("Act"), the City Council of the City of Kansas City MO ("City") approved the Petition for Establishment of the Red Bridge Shopping Center Community Improvement District ("Petition"), thereby creating the Red Bridge Shopping Center Community Improvement District ("District"); and

WHERBAS, §67.1471.4 RSMo requires the District to prepare an annual report ("Annual Report") providing, among other things, services provided, revenues collected, and expenditures made during the past fiscal year fiscal year, and submit the Annual Report to the City, MO Department of Boonomic Development ("DED"), MO Department of Revenue ("DOR"), and MO State Auditor ("Auditor");

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District authorizes Counsel to prepare and deliver an Annual Report for fiscal year ending April 30, 2024, to the City, DED, DOR, and Auditor; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the appropriate officers, collectively and individually, are authorized to take all actions necessary to carry out the actions contemplated by and the intent of this Resolution.

## Resolution 2024:04 Authorize Levy of Special Assessment Adopted January 25, 2024

WHERBAS, by Ordinance No. 150780, adopted on September 17, 2015, and pursuant to the Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67,1401 et seq., RSMo, as amended ("Act"), the City Council of the City of Kansas City MO approved the Petition for Batablishment of the Red Bridge Shopping Center Community Improvement District ("Petition"), thereby creating the Red Bridge Shopping Center Community Improvement District ("District"); and

WHERRAS, pursuant to Resolution 2015-13, passed by the Board of Directors on December 29, 2015, the District desires to continue collection of the special assessments by stating the exact amount and methodology of the levy of special assessments, including the date on which the special assessments are to be collected and authorizing Jackson County, Missouri to collect same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Special Assessment Petition, the District hereby enacts the levying of the CID Special Assessment in the amount of one dollar and forty-seven cents (\$1.47) per square foot of usable building area within the District for the tax year stated herein.

### THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- Property Benefited. It is found that tracts of land listed in Special Assessment Petition will
  receive special benefits from the improvements and services in the District.
- 2. CID Special Assessment. CID Special Assessment is hereby levied for the calendar year 2024 against each tract of land listed on the Special Assessment Petition in the amount of one dollar and forty-seven cents (\$1,47) per square foot of usable building space within District and shall be collected on or before December 31, 2024. For purposes of CID Special Assessment, usable building area shall be defined as gross leasable area within District. At the time of adoption of this Resolution, gross leasable area within District equates to 137,352 square feet.
- 3. <u>Collection of Special Assessments</u>. Appropriate officers of the District are authorized and directed to take all such actions as are necessary and desirable to cause the Collector of Jackson County, MO to bill and collect CID Special Assessment as provided in this Resolution and in the Special Assessment Petition.
