TO APPROVE THE HEALTH SCIENCES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
OFFICERS AND MAY 1 TO APRIL 30 2024-25 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City Council of Kansas City (the “**City Council**”) approved the Petition to establish the Health Sciences Community Improvement District (the “**HSCID**”) in Ordinance No. 200810 on the 10th day of February, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors approved the ByLaws for the Health Sciences Community Improvement District (“**Bylaws**”).

WHEREAS, the ByLaws provide for one (1) year terms for the officers of the District, which are currently Niki Donawa, Chair; Jodi Coombs, Treasurer; and Troy Lillebo, Secretary.

WHEREAS, Dean Melchert served a two year term as Initial Directors and desires to stay on the Board. Sallie Guezuraga and Morgan Said completed terms of Initial Directors and desire to stay on the Board.

WHEREAS, Mitzi Cardenas has served a two year term and will resign from the Board.

WHEREAS, University Health has nominated Gabe Zorogastua to serve as a Successor Director of the Board.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint Troy Lillebo Chair of the Board of Directors for a one (1) year term, Gabe Zorogastua for a one (1) year term as Treasurer and Sallie Guezuraga for a one (1) year term as secretary year term effective April 1, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to approve the Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-25, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HEALTH SCIENCES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THAT:

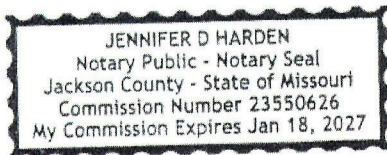
