
### Ordinance 240562 Community Wellness Ambassadors (CWA)


- This grant funds annual cohorts consisting of residents reporting to the Health Department monthly for training before returning to their communities to share the information, aiming to foster a healthier Kansas City.
- This year, the ambassadors have conducted 35,000 activities throughout Kansas City, with an additional 74,100 activities reported throughout Fall and Winter 2023.
- Running a program of this scale naturally incurs operating costs. All Community Wellness
  Ambassadors receive a monthly stipend that reflects our appreciation for each ambassador's
  contributions as the program continues to grow. Additionally, we incur administrative costs
  for financial and catering services.
- The cohorts run on a 10-month cycle, ending in May. During this period, administrative staff assists with event planning and coordination, data gathering, and collaboration with the Community Capital Fund for fiscal management.





### **Program Operations**







# The Community Wellness Ambassador Program Overview








### 2024 CWA REACH Data
