To eliminate one of the requirements that will not allow a liquor licensed premise to be located within 100 feet of a church or school.

Discussion

The ordinance currently states that no alcoholic beverage license shall be issued within 100 feet of a church or school unless the location has five or more buildings located together and is managed and marketed as a single mixed use development.

This change will make it possible for a liquor licensed business to be located within 100 feet of a church or school provided that the managing authority of the church or school has no objection.
