Congratulating Duaa Mohamed on being newly elected as Governor at Missouri Girls State for 2021.

WHEREAS, the American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) held their 79th session of Missouri Girls State from June 20-26, 2021, at the University of Central Missouri with 465 total delegates from the 2020 and 2021 sessions in attendance due to last year's Covid cancellation; and

WHEREAS, ALA Missouri Girls State is designed to help girls develop leadership skills by forming their own society and setting up local and state governments including the opportunity to run for office or be appointed to a post while others will support their community and candidates for their choice; and
