Ordinance No. 230362 3% Sales Tax - Recreational Marijuana

Purpose

 Codifies 3% sales tax approved by voters on April 4, 2023

• Uses (Resolution No. 230159)

- One-third to each of:
 - 1. Neighborhood clean up
 - 2. Homelessness response efforts
 - 3. Violence prevention efforts

Effective Date

- October 1, 2023 per Missouri Dept of Revenue
- First revenues to City expected in December 2023

Estimated Revenue

- \$3 million annually
- FY2023-24 prorated revenue = \$1.25 million

Ordinance No. 230363 Hotel and Short Term Rental License Fees

Purpose

- Codifies hotel and short-term rental license fees approved by voters on April 4, 2023
 - Modifies Section 40-111, Code of Ordinances, to increase the hotel license fee from \$1.50 to \$3.00
 - Creates Section 40-168, Code of Ordinances, to impose the \$3.00 license fee on short term rental units

• Uses

- 50% for repayment of project financing for T-Mobile Center
- 50% for Convention and Tourism purposes



Ordinance No. 230363 Hotel and Short Term Rental License Fees

Effective Date

- August 1, 2023
- Collected by Finance Department, Revenue Division in same manner as current license fee.
- Staff has begun working with hosting platforms (AirBNB, VRBO, Expedia, etc.) to determine the best way to collect these new fees.

Estimated Revenue

- Additional Convention and Tourism revenue \$4.1 million annually
- Additional Arena Fee revenue \$250,000 annually
- FY2023-24 prorated amount \$3.1 million and \$187,500, respectively

Ordinance No. 230364 7.5% Transient Boarding and Accommodation Tax

Purpose

 Codifies 7.5% tax on short term rental units approved by voters on April 4, 2023

Effective Date

- August 1, 2023
- Collected by Finance Department, Revenue Division in same manner as existing hotel/motel tax
- Staff has begun working with hosting platforms (AirBNB, VRBO, Expedia, etc.) to determine the best way to collect these new taxes.

Uses

Convention and Tourism purposes

Estimated Revenue

- Approximately \$2.1 million annually
- FY2023-24 prorated amount = \$1.575million
