### **Executive Summary**

Authorizing a \$7,500,000.00 construction contract with Superior Bowen Asphalt Co., LLC, for the WD Asphalt and Concrete, City Wide, Renewal No. 1 project; and authorizing modifications to the contractual commitment between funds as long as the total contract amount does not change.

#### Discussion

#### **Project Justification**

The Water Services Department is undertaking this project to restore areas damaged due to water main breaks, sanitary sewer and stormwater infrastructure improvements.

#### **Project Description**

The scope of work to be provided under this contract entails repairing streets and adjacent curbs, sidewalks, driveways, yards, and other site-specific work as needed. If needed, some work may be performed to repair deteriorated areas at various Water Services Department facilities throughout Kansas City, in Cass, Clay, Jackson and Platte Counties, Missouri.

Work also includes resurfacing roads over water main replacement construction projects to bring them to new SR-1 standards, which changes the costs of restoring streets.

This contract is based on unit prices and will total \$15,000,000.00 maximum over two fiscal years for the cumulative of the original contract and proposed Renewal No. 1. Work will be performed throughout Kansas City, in Cass, Clay, Jackson, and Platte Counties, Missouri.

This proposed \$7,500,000.00 ordinance under Contract No. 9835-1 is for the first and final renewal option.

#### **Executed Contract Summary**

City Council approved a \$7,500,000.00 construction contract under Contract No. 9835 on December 14, 2023, which also authorized one successive renewal with City Council approval.

#### Term

The term of this contract's Renewal No. 1 is 365 calendar days.

#### MBE/WBE Goals

#### **Original Solicitation**

This project was advertised in accordance with the City's requirements. Public bids were opened on November 28, 2023 with 1 bidder responding.

#### Awardee/Subcontracting Participation

Superior Bowen Asphalt Co., LLC was originally selected for this project as the lowest, most responsive, and most responsible bidder with a bid amount of \$7,400,267.00, with subcontracting participation of 10% MBE and 10% WBE. The maximum obligation of the City for the work on the original contract was \$7,500,000.00.

The maximum obligation of the City for the work on this project for Renewal No. 1 will be \$7,500,00.00. M/WBE goals will be met with this renewal.
