Executive Summary

Amending Chapter 2, Code of Ordinances, by repealing Sections 2-931, 2-936, 2-937, and 2-938, and replacing them with new sections of like numbers and subject matters; and enacting Sections 2-940, "Major Events," and 2-941, "City Sponsored Events.".

Discussion

This legislation changes the code of ordinances to create new processes for use of the Neighborhood Tourist Development fund for City sponsored events and major events.

In the adopted fiscal year 2024 Budget, the NTDF appropriates \$2.4 million for contracts. This legislation amends the use of these appropriations, 20% of NTDF for the use of contracts appropriations for City sponsored events is \$485,657 in the current fiscal year, and 10% of NTDF for major events is \$242,828 in the current fiscal year.
