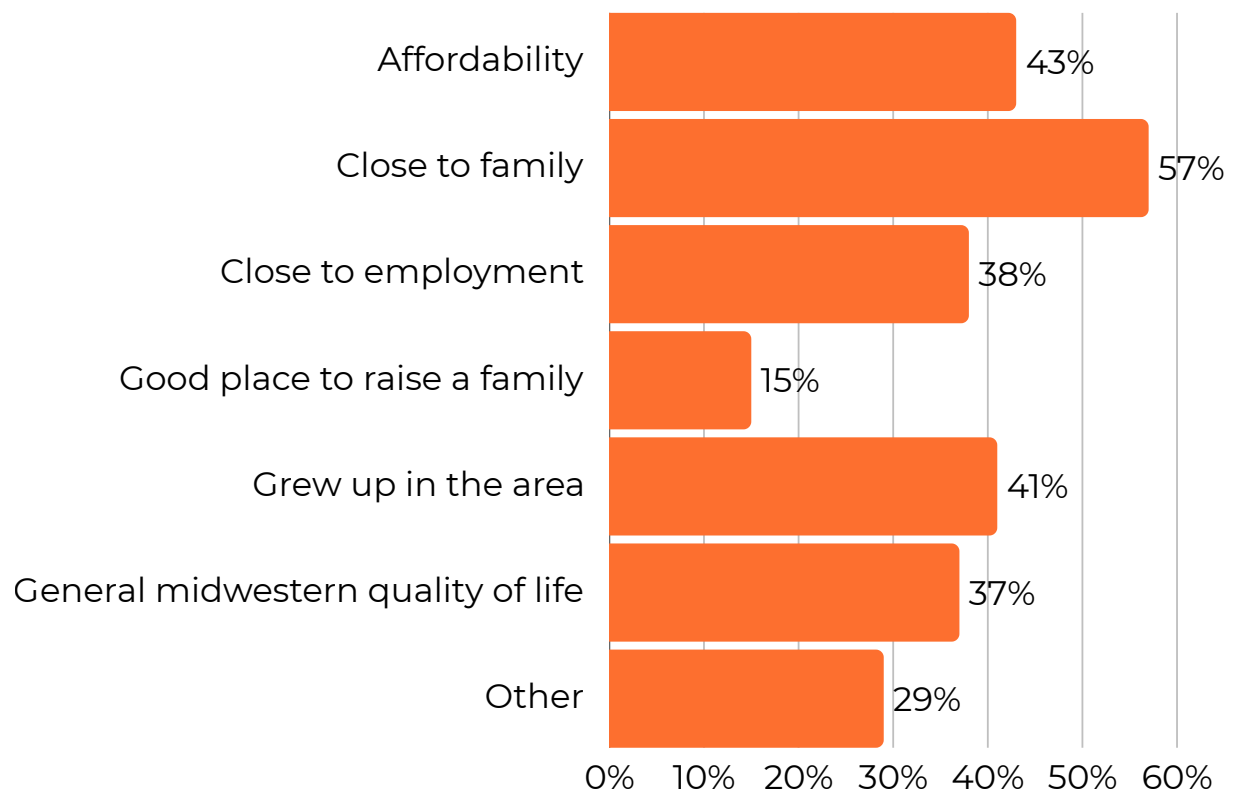

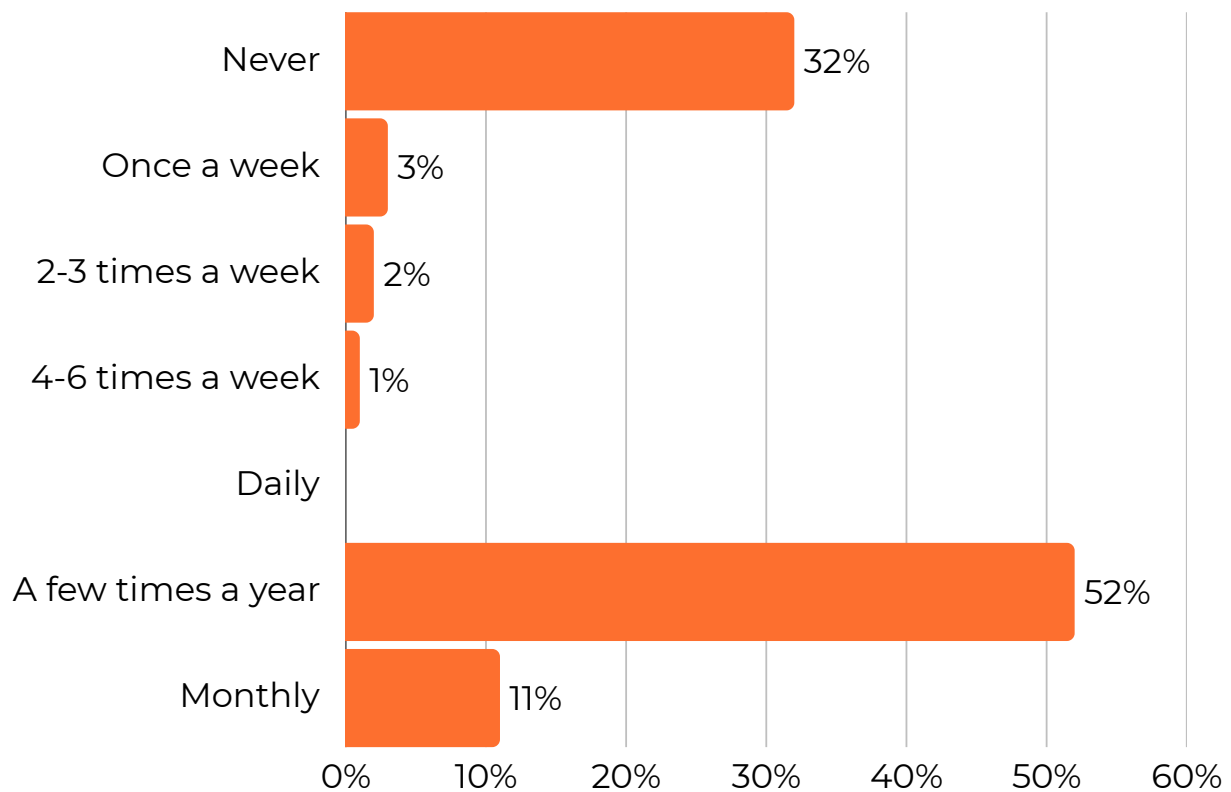
Excluding trips to your place of work, how often do you visit downtown?

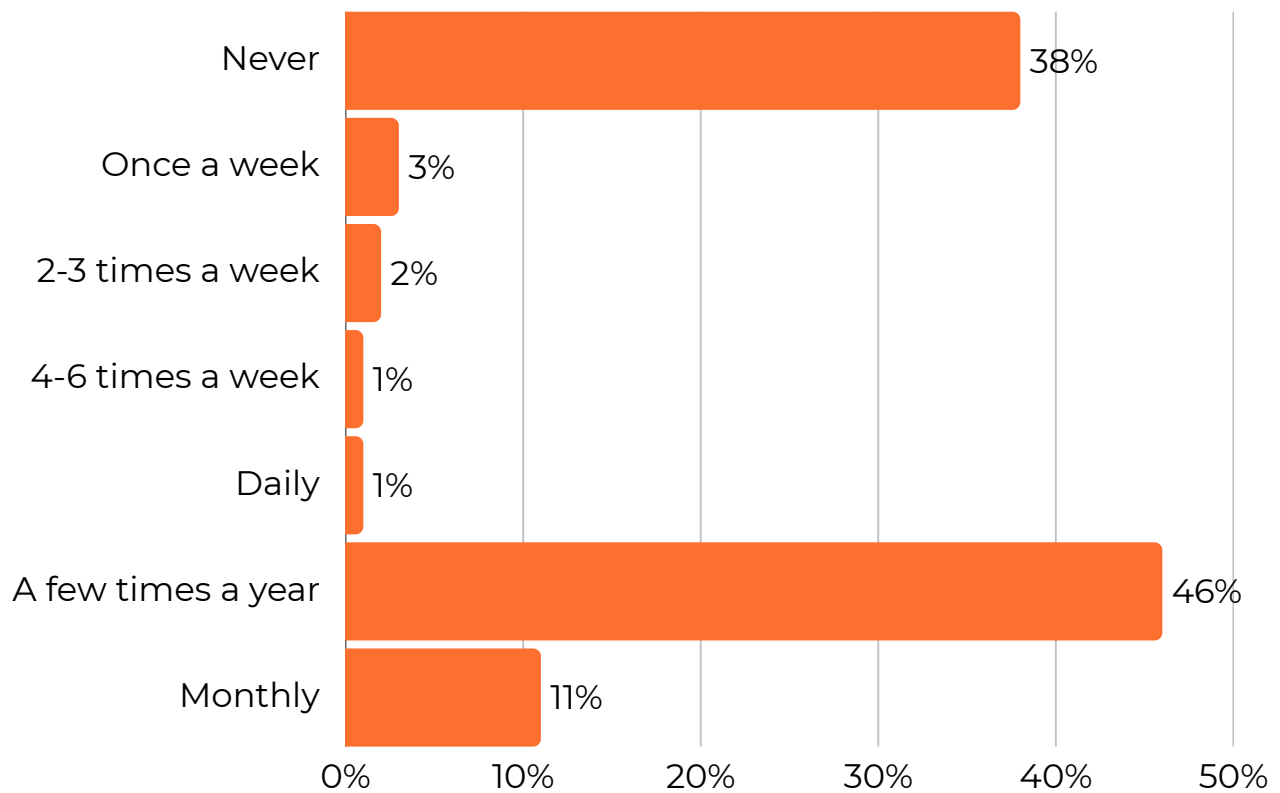
Excluding trips to your place of work, how often do you visit power and light?

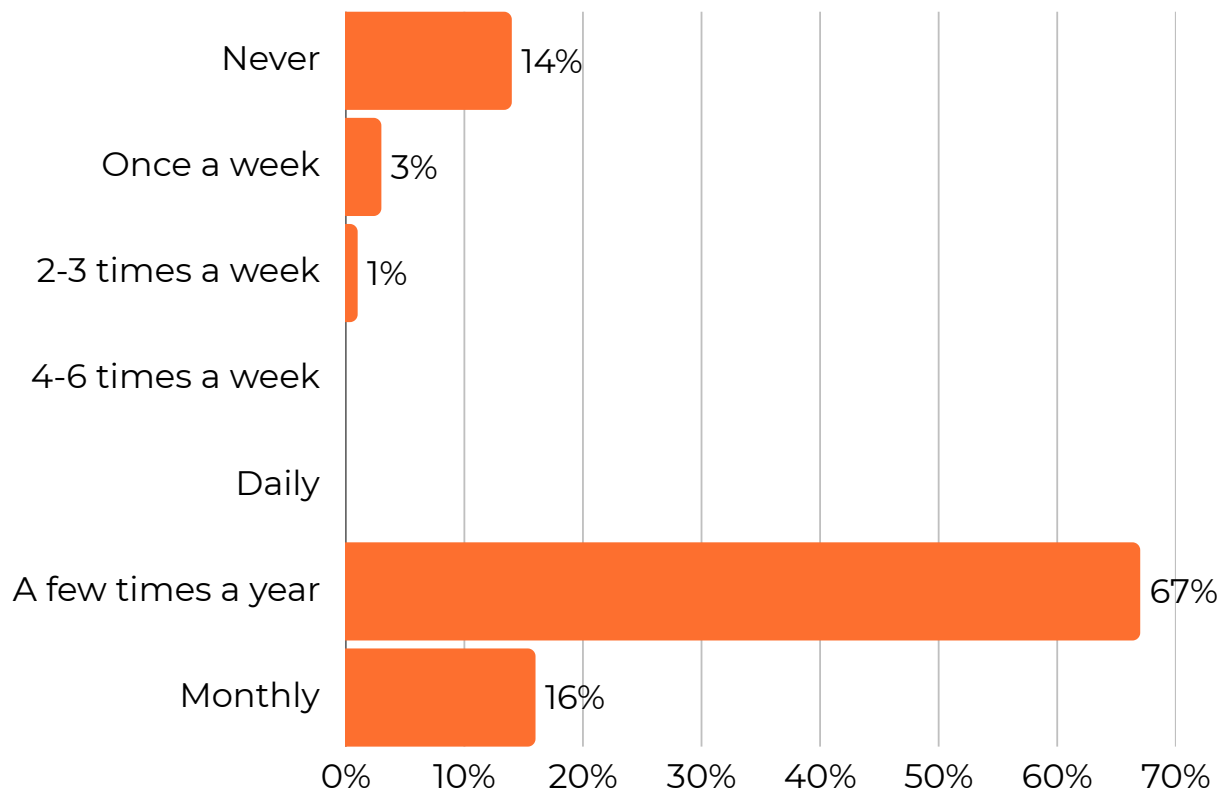

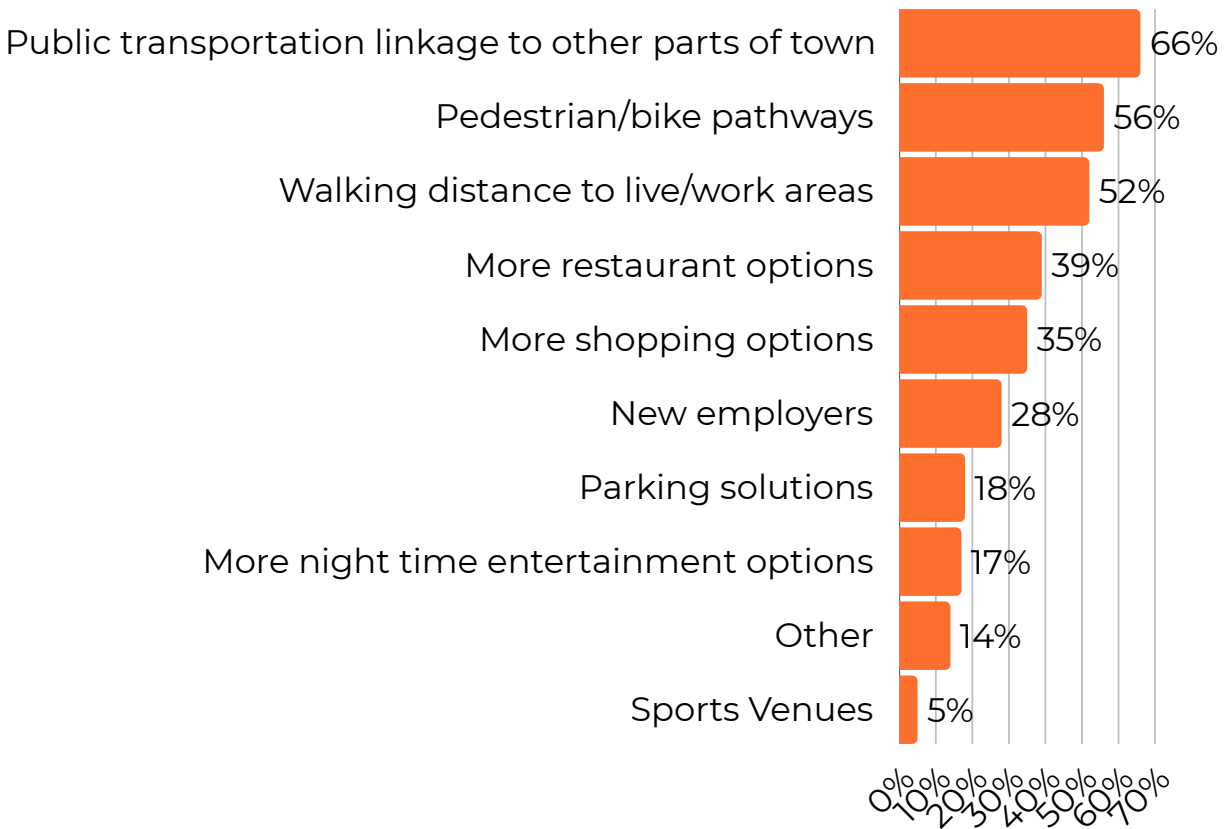
