<p>Reason for Legislation</p> <p>Proposed changes to section 10-106, Extended hours permits, and section 10-261, Renewals, have been made which allows the director to waive the sales requirements in the year immediately prior if the applicant provides documentation that the licensed establishment was closed or had reduced sales in the year immediately prior because of an event or occurrence outside of the control of the license or permit holder that resulted in a state of emergency lasting more than two weeks, as declared by the Mayor or governor of Missouri.</p>	<p>Sponsor(s) City Councilmember Andrea Bough.</p>										
<p>Discussion <i>(including relationship to other Council actions)</i></p> <p>Regulated Industries Division has seen businesses struggling to meet the sales requirements this year due to the ongoing pandemic involving covid-19. The Division processes the renewal of liquor applications in March, July and November annually. There were a handful of businesses renewed their licenses in March and struggled to meet the \$125,000.00 minimum requirement to keep their 3:00 a.m. permit or struggled to meet the minimum \$200,000.00 of food sales to meet restaurant-bar requirement.</p> <p>These ordinance changes will allow businesses to keep their liquor licenses intact while we continue to deal with the pandemic.</p>	<p>Programs, Departments, or Groups Affected None.</p>
