RESOLUTION NO. 260643

Recognizing the Pembroke Hill girls soccer team and Head Coach Matthew T. Pritchett for their first-place victory at the MSHSAA Missouri State Class 1 Soccer Championship on June 6, 2026.

WHEREAS, this event marks the Pembroke Hill girls soccer team's first Class 1 State Championship victory in history; and

WHEREAS, the team secured their lead in the first half, scoring two goals and further solidifying their position with a third goal in the second half, winning the game with a score of 3-1; and

WHEREAS, the Raiders finished their season with a 11-8-1 record and outscored their opponents 35-1 in their five postseason matches; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Pritchett, the team's senior goalie, was named the MSHSAA Class 1 Goalkeeper of the year and All-Region Goalkeeper; and

WHEREAS, Colbie Hyde, the team's senior center back, was named the MSHSAA Class 1 Player of the Year and All-Region Defender; and

WHEREAS, Head Coach Matthew T. Pritchett was named Private School Coach of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Maddie Novak, Glory Toney, and Phoebe Toney received All-Region Honors; NOW, THEREFORE,
