REGULATION NUMBERS 65845 THROUGH 65855 INSTALLATIONS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (b) of Section 70-38 of the “Code of General Ordinances of Kansas City, Missouri” and subject to the provisions thereof, traffic regulations are hereby made and adopted as follows:

Reserved parking for **Physically Disabled Persons** is hereby established, as indicated below, and shall be added to the lists as contained in **Sections 70-534** and **70-535**:

65845	18th Street, south side, from a point 30 feet east of Grand Boulevard then east 20 feet	Accessible Parking
65846	Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 28 feet north of 10th Street then north 20 feet	Accessible Parking
65847	Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 71 feet north of 16th Street then north 45 feet	Accessible Parking
65848	Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 30 feet north of 17th Street then north 48 feet	Accessible Parking
65849	Baltimore Avenue, west side, from a point 26 feet north of 17th Street then north 44 feet	Accessible Parking
65850	Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 49 feet north of 18th Street then north 30 feet	Accessible Parking

65851	Central Street, east side, from a point 40 feet north of 11th Street then north 50 feet	Accessible Parking
65852	Main Street, west side, from a point 60 feet south of 9th Street then south 25 feet	Accessible Parking
65853	Main Street, east side, from a point 182 feet south of 9th Street then south 27 feet	Accessible Parking
65854	Main Street, east side, from a point 111 feet south of 14th Street south 20 feet	Accessible Parking
65855	Walnut Street, east side, from a point 226 feet south of 17th Street then south 32 feet	Accessible Parking

The locations affected by the above regulations will be marked in accordance with standards prescribed in the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways” and said regulations shall become effective five days after publication in The Daily Record.
