### **Reason for Legislation**

To seek City Council approval and authorization of \$475,000.00 settlement of the lawsuit styled *Ligia Beckwith v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 1816-CV19787.

**Discussion** (including relationship to other Council actions)

Plaintiff was a City employee since February 2010. She worked her entire career with the City as a Chemist in the Water Laboratory. She claims she was discriminated against because of her gender and nationality, was subjected to a sexually hostile work environment, and was retaliated against. This settlement resolves any potential liability, punitive damages, potential future liability, and attorneys' fees.
