Authorizing a \$2,967,762.15 contract with Comanche Construction, Inc. for the Rehab Terminal B and C Bridges at the KCI Airport; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$3,264,538.37.

This project will also remove and replace the concrete decks of two bridges located in economy parking.
