Honoring the Fall 2012 Midwest Quad Conference of the American Institute of Architecture Students: Growing Communities.

WHEREAS, in 2012, a group of 300 architecture students from the Midwest Region were brought together in Kansas City, by the University of Kansas Chapter of the AIAS with the support and sponsorship of many offices and organizations in Kansas City and elsewhere, to discuss the future of the Profession of Architecture; and

WHEREAS, from there these students pursued four goals: supplementary architectural education focusing on sustainability and urban agriculture, professional development, realistic sustainable design strategies through the use of local case studies, and the strengthening of the community of future professionals; and


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:
