[Note: To authorize the Director of Parks and Recreation to approve a supplemental agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation for transferring grant funding from the Cliff Drive Recreational Improvements project to the Cliff Drive and Spirit of KC Scenic Bways Trail Project in the amount of \$94,102.20 in federal funds.

Discussion (explain all financial aspects of the proposed legislation, In response to Resolution #29919, the Parks and Recreation Department has coordinated the design and construction efforts of these two Cliff Drive Projects with the State of Missouri Department of Transportation.

Proposed is a supplemental agreement which will permit the City of Kansas City, Missouri and MoDOT to transfer funding from SBMO11001 to SBMO12001 in the amount of

Project Justification

This project will provide additional recreation opportunities for byway visitors by connecting Cliff Drive to the Spirit of Kansas City Scenic Byway as well as "Bike KC" and "Trails KC" routes, Berkley Park, and trails in North Kansas City and Kansas. This project will provide additional bike and pedestrian facilities that connect one scenic byway to another, extending the recreational trails enjoyed by visitors. It will also draw patrons from the downtown River Market to Cliff Drive to experience the byway and the historic, natural and recreational opportunities it offers.

Project Description This grant is providing funds to connect the Spirit of Kansas City Byway and the Cliff Drive Scenic Byway with a 10 foot wide concrete trail. Trail Heads at Highland Avenue and Dora Street consist of ADA accessible concrete ramps and landings. A second trail will connect the parking area on The Paseo to the trail head at Highland Avenue. A third trail will connect the parking area at the gazebo located at Highland Avenue to the south entrance gate to Cliff Drive at Lexington Avenue. Wayfinding signage and bikeway signage will be placed along the byways between Belmont Avenue and Wyandotte Avenue.

Is it good for the children?

This trail project will benefit the children of Kansas City by providing a non-vehicular connection between two historic areas of Kansas City. The Spirit of KC Scenic Byways Trail on the west preserve some of the oldest and most historic parts of bi-state
