


# ORDINANCE 240555: The Children & Youth with Special Health Care Needs (CYSHCN) Program




## Ordinance 240555 The Children & Youth with Special Health Care Needs (CYSHCN) Program

- Request approving a one-year contract and appropriating an additional \$123,000.
- This annual grant supports coordination services for children and youth diagnosed with special health care needs in Jackson, Cass, Clay, Platte, and Ray counties.
- Service coordination ensures that children and youth with special health care needs receive continuous care in a family-centered, comprehensive, and accessible medical home.
- The program is a payer of last resort, and as such provides limited funding for medically necessary diagnostic and treatment services.
