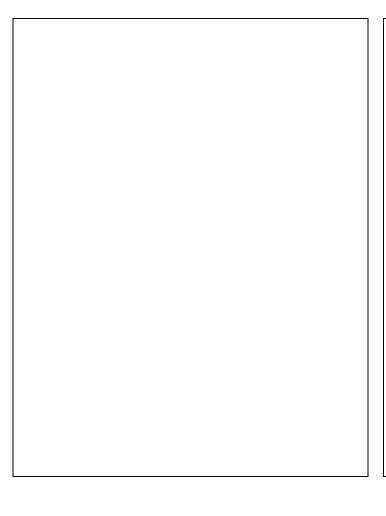
**Brief Title**

Reason for Project This final plat application was initiated by Platform Ventures, in order to subdivide the property in accordance with the city codes and state statutes. (The developer intends to construct an industrial complex.)
Discussion This is a routine final plat ordinance that authorizes staff to continue to process the plat for recording. This plat can be added to the consent agenda.
Case No. CD-CPC-2020-00122 approved by Ordinance No. 200816 on October 1, 2020 allowed for the development plan which also served as a preliminary plat for "Project Rhino". The proposed request is in substantial conformance to the controlling plan.

The site is currently a large surface asphalt lot formerly part of the Richards-Gebaur airfield and now operated as part of the I-49 Industrial Facility (formerly the CenterPoint Intermodal Facility). The I-49 Industrial Center 1st Plat creates two lots associated with "Project Rhino" a 297,600 sq ft warehouse and distribution facility. The peak rate of storm water discharge and total runoff volume discharging to the public storm sewers will be maintained after redevelopment. The improvements will improve the overall aesthetics of the site and increase the tax base for the City.

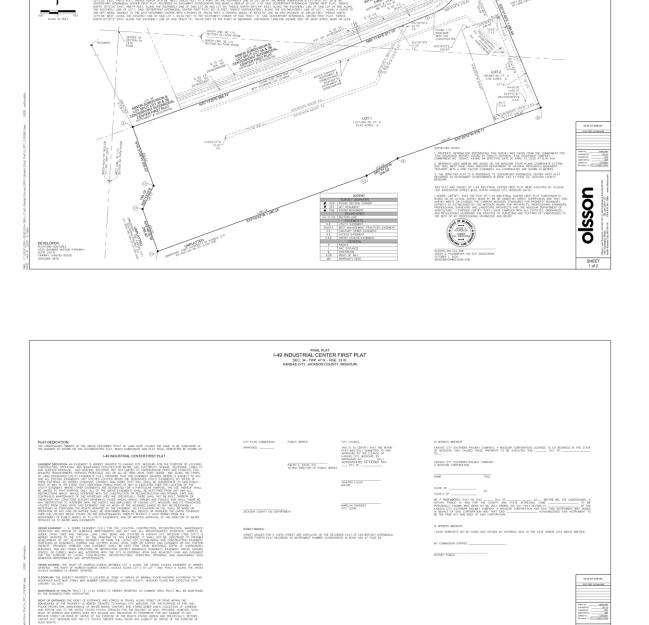
