<p>Reason for Legislation Resolution of the Workers' Compensation claim of Firefighter, Amy Jo Ervin. Ms. Ervin sustained an injury to her head, neck, face and body as a whole as the direct result of an occupational accident on December 18, 2012.</p>
<p>Discussion <i>(including relationship to other Council actions)</i> Ms. Ervin fell and struck her head and neck on the side of the fire truck. She sustained permanent injuries to her head. She suffered hemiplegia and required hospitalization. She required extensive medical care and rehabilitation. She received \$295,853.00 in medical benefits. She was unable to return to her job as a firefighter. We have agreed to resolve her claim for 27.5% of the body and indemnify her for the medical bills paid by Blue Cross/Blue Shield. This is a payment in the amount of \$52,563.96.</p>
