Individuals living with HIV/AIDS are required to enroll in Medical Case Management to verify to receive services and access Ryan White Part A core medical services. Funding for ambulatory and primary care services ensures that residents living with HIV/AIDS, within the KC TGA, receive appropriate health care services and treatment of their disease through federal and local funding.

Is it good for the children?

Yes, these services are provided to children and youth living with HIV/AIDS. Last year, over 22% of clients served were women, youth, infants, and/or children.
