The Environmental Management Commission recommends an addition to the Transportation & Infrastructure lobbying priorities for Missouri to include improvements to pedestrian access to transit services. We offer the following language for your consideration.

## ***Transportation & Infrastructure***

- **Transportation Funding.** Support efforts to raise new revenues and allow state funding to address all current and future transportation needs, including the provision of zero-fare transit and expanded bus service so KCATA can better serve Kansas City's workforce and employers. **Support service access by funding first-mile and last-mile elements for transit trips, including sidewalk and trail development.**
