WHEREAS, the City Planning and Development Department is the enforcement agency for all permitted construction activity on private property, and the Plans Review Division reviews plans to assure compliance with the building code; and

WHEREAS, the Department has plans review, contractor licensing, permitting and field inspection professionals who work to ensure that buildings, structures, and building service equipment are constructed or installed according to the minimum standards set forth in the building codes; and

WHEREAS, the Department's Construction Code Inspectors performed 58,149 inspections including elevator inspections in 2017 and Permits Division staff processed \$532,229,685.00 in residential building permits and \$661,460,709.00 in non-residential building permits in 2017; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That the Mayor and Council hereby honor the City Planning and Development Department's Building Code Professionals during Building Safety Month; and
