Missouri law, RSMo Section 479.011(b) allows any home rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants located in more than one county to establish, by order or ordinance, an administrative system for adjudicating parking and other civil nonmoving municipal code violations. Kansas City is a home rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants located in more than one county.
