**Comments:** A modification (RFM) was approved on the original contract (9835) to add additional subcontractors and to lower the goals to 6% MBE and 6% WBE. That modification of the goals does not apply to the renewal. The prime contractor has provided a plan to meet the original goals of 10% MBE and 10% WBE on the renewal with the additional subcontractors approved on the original contract. The prime contractor indicated that they will be able to meet the goals, as modified, on the original contract of 6% MBE and 6% WBE.

According to B2G, the prime contractor is currently achieving the following participation on the contract:
