The First Amendment to the TIFC Agreement will extend the agreement for a period of five years.

Amendment No. 5 of the CHV Agreement increases the amount of the contract by \$170,112.00 to a total of \$1,908,421.00 and extends the term of the contract through October 31, 2021.

The amount of the increase equals one-half of the Amendment No. 4 increase.

Actual compensation will be based on the number of hours worked on the contract, with different hourly rates being applied to work performed by Certified Public Accountants (CPAs) and all other staff
