PROFESSIONAL, SPECIALIZED OR TECHNICAL SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 4 PROJECT NO. FINTIF-2016 FINANCE DEPARTMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 4 ("Fourth Amendment") is between **KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI**, a constitutionally chartered municipal corporation ("City"), and **COCHRAN HEAD VICK & CO., P.C.** ("Contractor"). City and Contractor agree to amend the above-referenced Contract (the "Contract") as follows:

Sec. A. Sections Amended. PART I, SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS, is hereby amended as follows:

Paragraph A of Section 1, Compensation, is deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

A. The amount the City will pay Contractor under this Contract will not exceed **\$1,738,309.00** unless an amendment to this Contract providing for additional compensation shall have been mutually executed by the parties. The amount to be paid to the Contractor in fiscal year 2020-21 will not exceed \$340,224.00. Contractor will be paid on an hourly basis at the blended hourly rates provided for in **EXHIBIT A**, attached hereto.

Section 6, Term of Contract, is deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

Sec. 6. Term of Contract.

The services to be provided by Contractor pursuant to this Contract will continue through and including **April 30, 2021**.

Sec. B. Sections Not Amended. All other sections of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

Sec. C. Effectiveness; Date. This Fourth Amendment will become effective when all parties have signed it. The date this Amendment is signed by the last party to sign it will be deemed the date of this Fourth Amendment.
