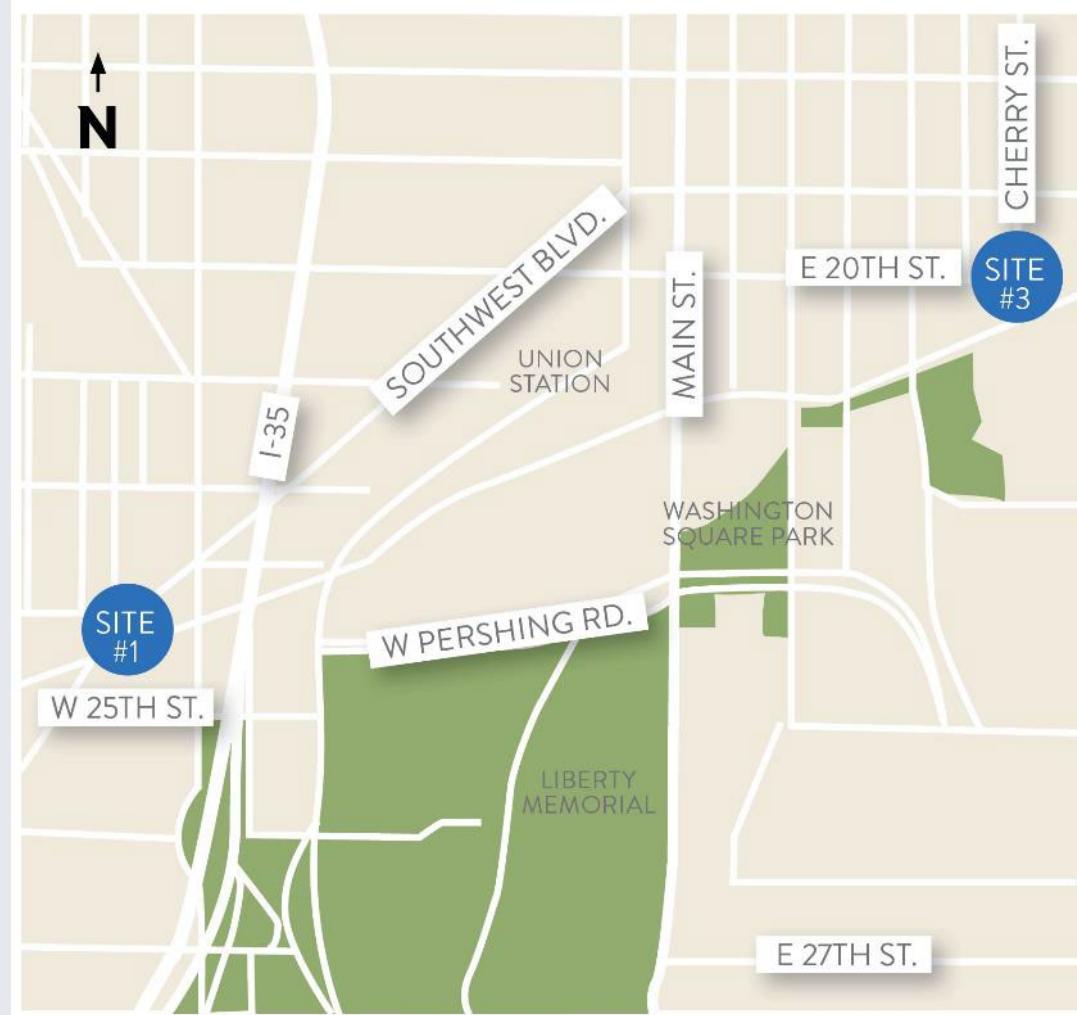




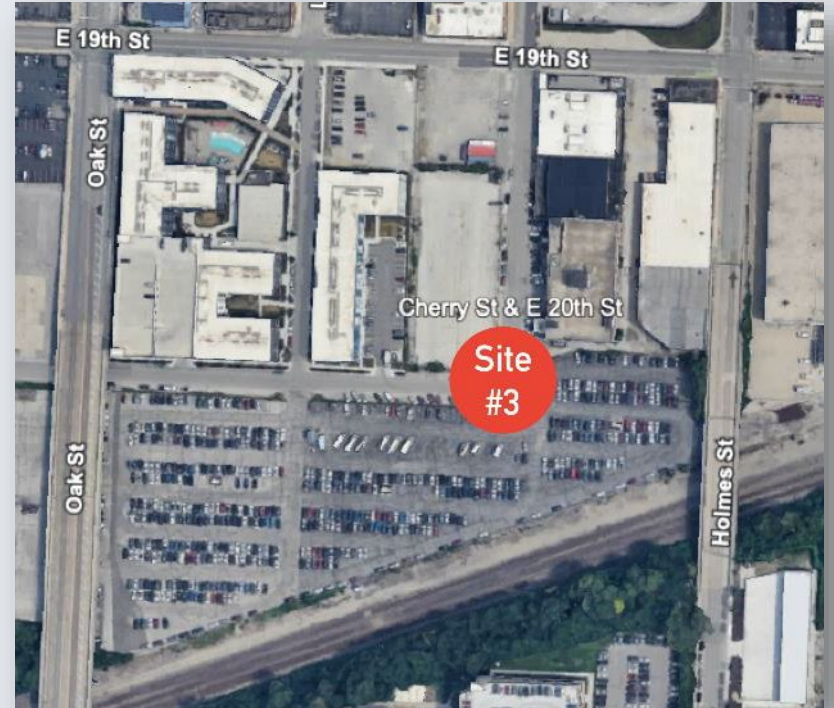
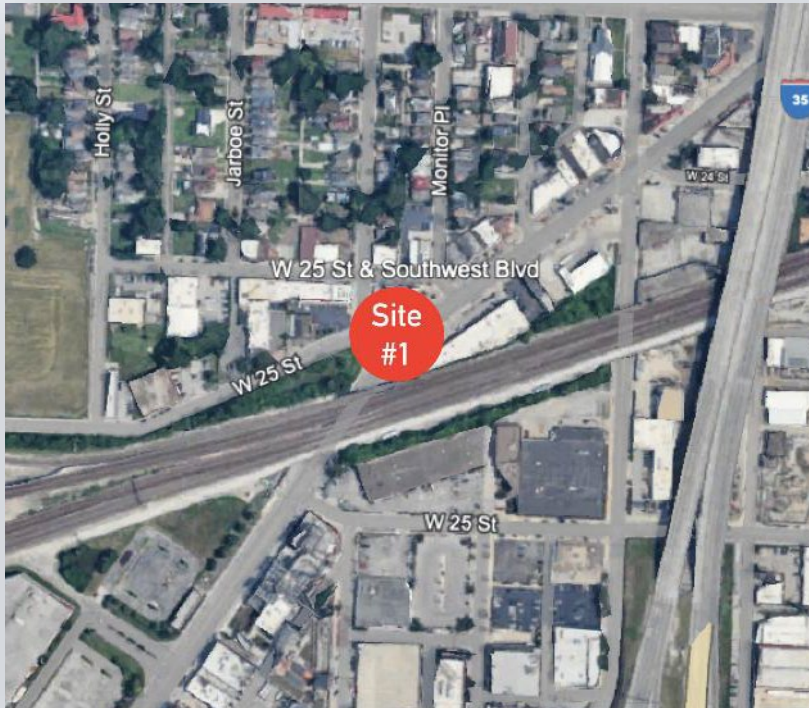

INFRASTRUCTURE UPDATE

OK Creek Additional Storage Facilities Project

KC Water is working to design and construct important improvements to the wastewater system in your neighborhood. This project will include the installation of two in-line bending weir storage facilities. KC Water originally identified three potential sites for this project, but has narrowed the focus to two primary sites. When complete, the project will improve the capacity of the wastewater collection system and reduce the volume of sewer overflows into local waterways and the potential for basement backups.
