Executive Summary

Authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to execute Amendment No. 1 to the contract with WCA of Missouri, LLC; and authorizing the Manger of Procurement Services to further amend the contract and exercise three (3) additional one-year renewal options; reducing the Contingent Appropriation of the General Fund by \$1,435,000.00 and appropriating that amount in the General Fund for the City’s recycling contract due to an increase in rates for recycling carts and processing fees; and designating requisitioning authority.

Discussion

This legislation appropriates funds and authorizes an amendent to the contract with WCA of Missouri LLC, due to an increase in rates for recycling carts and processing fees.
