Nicolas Bosonetto, Public Works and Nick Folk presented. This ordinance, authorizes the Director of Public Works to execute a design professional services agreement with Alfred Benesch & Company for the Citywide Biennial Bridge Inspection program toward compliance with Federal requirements. The requirements dictate that all bridges and large culverts are inspected every two years. City staff is inspecting culverts in the City. The consultant will inspect all the bridge length structures and enter all of the City inspection data into the State of Missouri database controlled by MoDOT. This project will access the City's transportation structural system to obtain the condition of bridges, and update data used in decisions for maintenance, rehabilitation, and reconstruction. This helps make the streets and bridges safer for traffic, thus allowing citizens safe travel along city streets.
