Reason for Legislation

Authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with Worldwide Technologies (WWT) for \$2,854,937.49 to procure necessary hardware software in support of the Smart + Connected Communities” project approved by city council under ordinance 150287; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

Discussion

Contract Summary:

This contract will provide the necessary hardware and software to support the development of the Smart + Connect utilizing technology such as interactive digital kiosks, video as sensors that can be used for numerous purposes such as monitoring traffic and capturing data for future City use, smart lighting and numerous other applications.

Project Description: The Project involves the use of its network as the next utility for integrated city management, a better quality of life for citizens, a better visitor experience and for economic development reasons. The Project would make Kansas City, Missouri the largest smart city network in North America – once again putting the City at the forefront of innovation, technology and entrepreneurship; and will be organized around the 2.2 mile streetcar starter line and the adjacent districts of the River Market, Power & Light and Crossroads, taking advantage of the construction already underway.

Solicitation: In accordance with Section 3-7 (a) 1 d., the city contracted with Worldwide Technologies as the strategic partner with Cisco as sole authorize reseller for hardware and software to market this capability.
