Approving a settlement of \$800,000.00 for Brenda Paikowski v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, Jackson County Circuit Court Case Number: 2216-CV16157.

Discussion

Plaintiff Brenda Paikowski filed a lawsuit claiming discrimination and retaliation related to her employment with the City and intends to file a second lawsuit related to constructive discharge. The proposed settlement resolves all liability, damages, and attorneys' fees for any claims Ms. Paikowski could have against the City. The Law Department and Risk Management Committee recommend accepting the settlement.
