Conforms with State and Local Laws and Best Practice



City Charter Sec. 836 – requires an independent certified annual audit



Must use CPA firms experienced in governmental auditing and must be selected through a competitive process



Missouri law requires submission of the audit to the State Auditor



Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) recommends multi-year agreements of at least five years – City Charter does not allow us to exceed five years (Sec. 836)



Scope of Services and Timeline

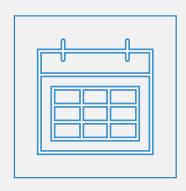
- Annual audit of City and component unit financial transactions, grants, pension systems, and other auditrelated services
- Audit must be completed by October 31, 2024
 - Submission to Missouri State Auditor
 - Submission to GFOA for Excellence in Financial Reporting Award
 - The City has been the recipient of this award 34 consecutive times!

RFP issued on March 21, 2024

Four responses were received for the RFP

Evaluation Team consisted of **six members**

The proposal by Allen, Gibbs, and Houlik, L.C. (**AGH**) was selected AGH conducted the **audit for FY19-23**

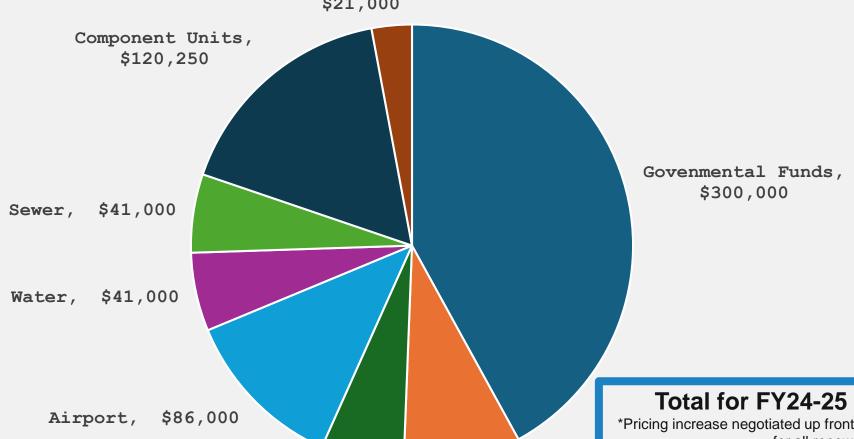
Contract is a **one-year contract with four (4) one-year renewals**CREO MBE goals were set at **20%**
