

Reason For Legislation

The proposed fourth amendment provides for revisions to the redevelopment schedule by extending the time to complete demolition by 6 months (from fall 2015 to fall 2016) and the time to begin construction by 6 months (from spring 2016 to fall 2016).

The City Council approved the 45th Street TIF Plan by Committee Substitute for Ordinance No. 061321 on December 14, 2006, and approved the First Amendment on April 26, 2007, by passage of Ordinance No. 070486, the Second Amendment on September 30, 2010, by passage of Ordinance No. 100774; and the Third Amendment on November 21, 2013, by passage of Ordinance No. 130879.

Proposed Fourth Amendment to the 45th Street TIF Plan: The proposed Fourth Amendment provides for revisions to the Estimated Development Schedule which would extend the time of commencement of demolition and commencement of construction by 6 months.

The purpose of the 45th Street TIF Plan is to provide for replacement of the Holiday Inn located at 45th & Main with a state of the art mixed use community consisting of 274,500 s.f. of Class A office space, 47,000 s.f. of specialty grocery and retail space, a 160 room boutique hotel, 1,060 parking spaces, and a 55,000 s.f. public park linking public spaces from the Plaza to Mill Creek Park to Southmoreland Park and the public art museums to the east.
