# Enterprise Permitting System

- The City's Enterprise Permitting and Licensing (EP&L) system and its corresponding solutions, integrations and dependencies are highly used by multiple City departments and the public to automate and centralize land management, permitting, inspections and code enforcement.
- Primary City Departments and Usage:
  - **City Planning and Development:** a centralized, digital platform used to manage the entire life cycle of development projects (online plan submissions, electronic plan reviews, automated permit issuance and GIS-integrated land use planning).
  - **Public Works:** used to streamline infrastructure management (enable tracking and managing permitting, inspections, and code compliance).
  - **Neighborhood Services:** used to centralize property data, automate code enforcement workflows, manage permits and inspections, track violations, access history. Open Data used to help share information transparently with the public. Also currently using for 311 case

# Enterprise Permitting System

The current systems/processes utilized by the Health Department to manage inspections for Healthy Homes, Food Establishments, Childcare Facilities and Lodging Establishments are inefficient, standalone and distributed system, uses outdated technology and poses mild security risks due to use of unsupported software.
