WHEREAS, Mr. Mack succumbed to his injuries sustained when he and others came under gunfire while serving an eviction notice; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mack was a beloved member of the Circuit Court family that took pride in simply doing his job and putting others in the court and community at large before himself; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mack's passing is a loss for his family, friends, fellow Jackson County Circuit Court colleagues and those throughout Jackson County for which he served so honorably, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That the Mayor and Council hereby honor the life and service of Jackson County Circuit Court Civil Process Server Drexel Mack; and
