Honoring Sherwin Carroll and the Honorable Judy Morgan for being named Labor's Representatives of the Year by Labor's Educational and Political Club, Independent (LEPCI).

WHEREAS, the selection of Sherwin Carroll and Representative Judy Morgan as Labor's Representatives of the Year by Labor's Educational and Political Club, Independent (LEPCI) was due to their hard work, dedication and decades of both service and leadership in the labor movement; and

WHEREAS, in 1985, Sherwin went to work for Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Local 96, where he was an Organizer/Union Representative and in 1991 was elected to the top position of Executive Director, becoming the first African-American elected to that position; and

WHEREAS, Sherwin currently serves as the Kansas City Director and Recording Secretary for SEIU, Local 1, and as the President of the SEIU Missouri/Kansas State Council; and

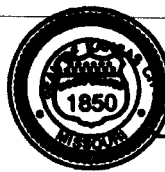
WHEREAS, Judy was a teacher since 1970 before retiring in 2009 and was an active member in the American Federation of Teachers (AFT), Local 691, including serving as Building Representative, Executive Board member, AFT national delegate and AFT Missouri State delegate before becoming President in 1999; and

WHEREAS, Judy has served as Missouri Legislative Chair for the Greater Kansas City Women's Political Caucus and Legislative Chair for Local 691 and was elected in 2011 as a Missouri State Representative; NOW, THEREFORE,
