<u>**Purpose:**</u> Approval of the Revised 3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment of the Downtown Library TIF Plan.

## Redevelopment Plan Area:

The Redevelopment Area, as amended, is generally bound by E. 9<sup>h</sup> Street on the north, E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street on the south, Wyandotte Street on the west, and Main Street on the east (the "Redevelopment Area"), all in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri.

**Purpose:** The Revised Third Amendment provides for: 1) the construction of specific public infrastructure improvements, which include the addition of street furniture, landscaping, pedestrian alley beautification, street trees, pedestrian lighting, curbs, side-walks, fire hydrants and such other streetscape improvements; 2) that certain public infrastructure improvements will commence in 2015 and shall be substantially complete by 2019; 3) provides for a decrease in the Budget of reimbursable Redevelopment Project Costs by \$5,263,656 for costs that relate to certain public infrastructure improvements and the total Budget of reimbursable Redevelopment Project Costs being reduced by \$11,574,226; 4) provides for modifications in the Sources and Uses, with the existing funds within the Special Allocation Fund will be used to fund the streetscape improvements; and 5) continues a PILOT - sharing arrangement from funds already in the Special Allocation Fund; with all future TIF revenues to be surplussed. The Downtown Library TIF Plan will be terminated as soon as all eligible costs have been reimbursed.
