I moved into the neighborhood as a reenter around 2007. I was able to purchase my home a few years ago, I am a proud homeowner. At the time I moved into the stacked duplex next door to my current home St. Lukes owned a large number of the single family homes through 'Westport Today' and managed by a local management company who did a decent job of maintaining them. My neighbors were artists, servers and workers. They lived in well crafted and built houses and duplexes even if some were a little run down from deferred maintenance. On Washington street there were around 2 dozen houses today there are 4 single family homes and one stacked duplex.

The two massive apartment buildings are not full and the tenants do not clean up after their pets. The smell is awful especially in the summertime. Also one of the buildings has exterior lights that are broken, fallen over and have exposed electrical wiring. The other has contaminated soil that reeks and everything they plant dies. I already have a building behind my house whose exterior lights are blinding in my backyard and shine in my bedroom windows. I don't need another poorly kept building to add to my problems.
