Purpose

- The Shelter + Care grant award is funded by HUD through the local housing Continuum of Care (CoC)
- Our Shelter + Care program provides permanent supportive housing for people with HIV and their families

Housing = healthcare

- Increased engagement in HIV medical care and treatment
- Increased viral suppression of HIV, which prevents HIV transmission
- Improves long-term health outcomes & quality of life for people with HIV

HIV CARE CONTINUUM:

The series of steps a person with HIV takes from initial diagnosis through their successful treatment with HIV medication



Background

- Originally funded in 2004, the City has applied and received renewal funding each year
- SAVE, Inc. is the Project Sponsor who provides direct client services, and with whom the funding application was collaboratively written

2023 Shelter + Care Funding

HUD Funds: \$439,912

KCMO Match (Health Levy): \$68,064

SAVE, Inc. Contract: \$499,276

KCHD Administration: \$82,905

- HUD funds
- Health Levy funds

2023 Shelter + Care Anticipated Outcomes

- 38 households housed (at least 1 member of the family living with HIV)
- 45 individuals housed
- 38 households receive supportive housing case management and/or housing navigation

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
