## **Executive Summary**

Providing for submission to the qualified voters of the City for their approval at a general election called for Tuesday, April 4, 2023 the question of modifying the license fee on hotels, motels and tourist courts; authorizing the imposition of a license fee on owners of short-term rentals; authorizing and directing the City Clerk to notify the responsible election authorities of this election; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

### **Discussion**

This ordinance would require participation in a special election for which the City would be responsible for the cost of election judges and a pro rata share of election costs. The exact cost of the election cannot be be estimated at this time because additional ballot items are not known. Previous special election costs have been approximately \$500,000. These funds are already appropriated in the FY 2022-2023 Budget.
