Approval of settlement of Claim File No. T2021-1075, 1125 Grand Boulevard LLC

Details

Reason for Legislation

To seek City Council approval and authorization of settlement of the Claim File No. T2021-1075, 1125 Grand Boulevard LLC.

Discussion (including relationship to other Council actions)

On February 12, 2021, a water main burst and caused property damage to the condominium apartments located at 1125 Grand Boulevard, Kansas City, Missouri. This was a Code 3 break on an 8-inch main. The main break was located next to the building. The pressure from the water caused a foundation wall to buckle which allowed the basement to flood to a depth of approximately thirty to thirty-six inches. The water flowed into the basement which housed thirty-five steel mesh storage units for building residents. To perform remediation services, the claimant initially hired PACT. A City contractor assumed this work less than one week after the break occurred. This ordinance will fully pay the claimant and the City's contractor.
