With such a high rate of evictions that take place in Kansas City, MO, it is unsurprising that we see such high rates of violence and low rates of high school graduation. When so much is at stake for families that are in danger of losing their homes, they should at least have the benefit of legal representation during these proceedings.

I implore you to support tenants in their access to legal representation during eviction proceedings. Our future is at stake.
