### **SECTION II**

#### PURPOSES OF CID AND SERVICES PERFORMED DURING FISCAL YEAR:

**Purpose:** Facilitate safety and security measures to assist patrons, residents and users to improve the safety conditions of the District; public area maintenance to improve the appearance and image of the CID; hire or contract for personnel to staff and provide services to the District, and marketing businesses and special events to increase patronage.

Specific Services: The CID has focused on Crime, Grime and Chime.

 $\underline{Crime}$  – A security team has been deployed on foot, by bicycle as well as by vehicle 14 hours a day, seven days a week, along with an overnight patrol, to address quality of life/business interference issues, i.e., trespassing, shoplifting and other street crimes affecting businesses on the Avenue. In excess of 1,100 incident reports were written, a CID representative attended court for Repeat Nuisance Offenders, and the security team assisted shoppers with flat tires, lock-outs and general safety/security issues.

<u>**Grime**</u> – Seven days a week, eight to ten Urban Street Ambassadors walked the Avenue, where they picked up thousands of pounds of trash and debris and collected materials for recycling from our primary business nodes. The CID has a working relationship with the City in which the Ambassadors recorded and reported infrastructure needs to the City for repair and replacement. They greeted customers, gave directions and informed potential customers of shopping opportunities.

<u>Chime</u> – The CID chimed in with marketing/branding ideas and designs and discussed with City officials, businesses in the district, and other partners how we could collaborate to accomplish the common goal of economic opportunities in the District. The CID provided educational opportunities for our very diverse refugee and immigrant business community.
