Project Justification

This agreement will provide for design professional project management services in order to oversee and manage the City's interests on over \$200M of current KCMO Public Works Capital Projects.

The PW Capital Projects Division currently is staffed by four (4) Project Engineers managing over 120 major projects throughout the city. Optimally, this group would be fully staffed with six (6) Project Engineers and seven (7) Project Managers in order to fully deliver our current backlog of projects as well as prepare for the anticipated surge of federal funding. This contract allows our Division to continue delivering projects in the short term until we are fully staffed, and is a temporary measure only.
