Executive Summary

Appropriating \$3,466,803.34 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Aviation Fund; and authorizing a \$15,271,223.36 contract with Vanderlande Industries Inc. for repair and maintenance service of baggage systems in the single terminal facility at Kansas City International Airport.

Discussion

This contract with Vanderlande Industries Inc. will provide labor for repair and maintenance service of baggage systems within the new single terminal facility at Kansas City International Airport.

Direct Labor Costs pertains to the Management, Maintenance and Support Staff responsible for the KCAD BHS Equipment. KCAD shall pay Contractor for the actual hours worked by Contractor's personnel based on the Contractor's actual cost for wages, workers' compensation, liability insurance, payroll taxes, Social Security and employee fringe benefits imposed on the basis of payrolls.

This Contract shall begin upon substantial completion on or about January 15, 2023 and shall end no later than April 30, 2028.

The maximum amount that City shall pay Contractor under this Contract shall not exceed fifteen million two hundred seventy one thousand two hundred twenty three dollars and thirty six cents (\$15,271,223.36) as follows:
