I've had multiple conversations with patrons where they tell me they have been looking for months for somewhere that will accept their voucher and if they don't find somewhere soon, their voucher will expire, and they will literally have nowhere to go. This should not be happening. It should not matter *how* you are paying your rent, as long as you *are* paying your rent.
