Authorizing a Lease Agreement with DHL Express (USA), Inc., Contract #6223030027 at Kansas City International Airport; and estimating F.Y. '24 revenue in the amount of \$48,650.68 to the Aviation Fund.

Discussion

Authorizing Lease Agreement #6223030027 for 50,000 square feet of Apron/Ramp Space at the MCI Air Cargo Center 1 Facility located at Kansas City International Airport from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2026, with the option to renew for one (1) additional two-year period.

Beginning January 1, 2024 DHL Express (USA) will pay an estimated FY '25 rental rate of \$145,952.04, plus three percent (3%) annual rental rate adjustment thereafter.
