


## Southtown TIF

#### Twelfth Amendment

The Twelfth Amendment to the Plan provides for the termination of Projects G and G-1 of the plan.

No vertical development has occurred in these project areas; however, the site has undergone environmental remediation.

#### Twelfth Amendment

- Project G is generally bounded by E. 60<sup>th</sup> Street on the north, Prospect Avenue on the east, E. 63<sup>rd</sup> Street on the south, and Brooklyn Avenue, Park Avenue and Olive Street on the west. Project G was approved by Ordinance No. 941450 in December 2001.
- Project Area G-1 is comprised of areas (1) bounded by 59<sup>th</sup> Street on the north, Bruce R. Watkins Drive on the east, E. 61<sup>st</sup> and E. 60<sup>th</sup> Streets on the south, and Prospect and Wabash Avenues on the west; (2) located at the northeast corner of E. 63<sup>rd</sup> Street and Brooklyn Avenue; and (3) located at the northeast corner of E. 63<sup>rd</sup> Street and Prospect.
- Although Project Area G-1 is referenced in the Plan, it has not been approved and designated by separate ordinance of the City Council.

#### Twelfth Amendment

The termination of Projects G and G-1 necessitates amendments to the budget of redevelopment costs, sources and uses of funds, and the development schedule to remove references associated with the terminated project areas.
